Thank you so much for your continued support and prayers for the work of Growing Young Cairnlea Trust. It's been a busy and encouraging season, and I'm excited to share a few highlights and prayer points with you.

In the run-up to the Easter holidays, I had the chance to lead a series of Explore Easter sessions in local schools. These sessions told the story of Easter—Jesus' death and resurrection—and gave young people space to reflect on what it means for them today. It was a privilege to share the heart of the gospel with so many pupils. Please pray that those who heard the message would continue to think about it and that God would be at work in their lives.

Over the holidays, I was involved in leading an SU camp at Lendrick Muir. We had 39 young people with us, and throughout the week we looked at the book of James, exploring what it means to live out our faith day by day. It was a brilliant time of fun, community, and meaningful conversations. Pray that the young people would grow in their understanding of who

Jesus is and how to follow Him.

Back in Airdrie. I've been thankful for the continued opportunities to take assemblies in both primary and secondary schools. It's amazing to have these open doors to speak about God's truth. Please pray for wisdom and creativity as I prepare and deliver these, and for lasting impact among the pupils. The SU groups at Airdrie Academy and Chapelhall Primary are still going strong. It's encouraging to see young people showing up week after week to open the Bible and ask honest questions. Pray that these groups would continue to grow in number and depth.

We've also just launched a
Friday drop-in café for
secondary pupils. It's early
days so please pray that more
young people would come
along and that we'd build
relationships that point them to
Jesus.
